SPARKLING WINES

PIEMONTE

Moscato Spumante, Toso (dolce/sweet)

A sweet sparkling wine obtained from a careful selection of Moscato grapes, pleasantly fragrant and moderate in alcohol. It has a pale straw colour with fine pearls

VENETO

Prosecco Spumante, Toso

Smooth, pale straw yellow coloured sparkling wine with a characteristic delicate and aromatic flavour. Extra dry.

WHITE WINES

PIEMONTE

Gavi di Gavi Grane 2009, Batasiolo

This elegant, fine white wine is made from Cortese grapes grown in the specific area of the village of Gavi. It stands out for its straw-yellow colour with greenish highlights, and for its typical white flower bouquet. Well bodied, fresh and dry, it has an inviting, harmonious taste.

VENETO

Soave Classico 2009, Villa Girardi

Elegant aroma, delicate and continuous with a characteristic of hint of flowers. On the palate, it is clean, gentle, very harmonious with hints of almonds.

SICILIA

La Segreta Bianco 2009, Planeta (Grecanico & Chardonnay)

Straw-yellow with lively aromatic bouquet. It is fruity and fragrant with apple, citrus and tropical fruit and lime on the nose. On the palate, it is fresh and flavoursome.

ROSÉ WINES

Roxé Pinot Nero, Toso

“ROXE” is a dry rosé wine with a creamy texture, while being very fresh and light. It displays notes of blackcurrant and cherries on the palate, with a great finish and very pleasant floral nose.

FROM ITALY...

RED WINES

PIEMONTE

Papagena Barbera d'Alba Superiore 2007, Fontanafredda P 1690.-
Dark ruby-red, with purple highlights; nose brimming with ripe fruit – especially plums and cherries - with hints of spices reminiscent of cinnamon and cloves.
The fruit blends marvelously with the soft tannins and the acidity. Medium-bodied.

Barbaresco Coste Rubin 2006, Fontanafredda P 2450.-
Ruby-red with garnet highlights; on the nose ripe plums, bilberries and violets merge harmoniously with hints of liquorice, cinnamon and tobacco.
Well-structured tannins and intense fruit fill the mouth with a closely-packed, full flavour.

Barolo Serralunga d'Alba 2009, Fontanafredda P 2630.-
Garnet-red with ruby highlights that take on slightly orange tone over time,
The wine has a clear cut, intense nose with overtones of vanilla, spices and roses.
The palate is dry but soft as well as full-bodied, velvety and well-balanced with good length

Barolo La Rosa 2001, Fontanafredda P 4280.-
Bright ruby/scarlet coloured wine. The aromas are an exotic mix of ripe dark fruits and leather with hints of dried porcini mushrooms. Smoky ripe plums show in the nose and on the palate that are followed by cherries and bitter oranges held in check by firm, tannins. The powerful complex fruit flavors are already starting to show through; a wine for long-term cellaring.

Barolo Boscareto 2003, Batasiolo P 4360.-
A bright garnet-red in colour. It has an ethereal, engaging nose, and an austere, well structured taste with overtone of tannins which blend perfectly with the bouquet.

TOSCANA

Chianti 2009, Leonardo da Vinci P 920.- *bottle*
A well-balanced wine of medium weight with jammy flavors of ripe plums, cherries, and red fruit. It has a deep crimson color and is a lively wine with a soft mineral finish and round tannins that linger in long, peppery finish. P 205.- *glass*

Chianti Riserva 2006, Leonardo da Vinci P 1320.-
Ruby red in colour, with rich chromatic nuances and a distinctly fruity bouquet where the cherry tone is mitigated by a hint of vanilla and cinnamon. The flavour reflects the spicy undertone of the aroma and is balanced by a fine tannic note.

ABRUZZO

Sangiovese Don Camillo 2008, Farnese P 1120.-
Intense garnet colour, fruity fragrance with jam aroma and a cherry preserved in alcohol scent, spicy notes of liquorice, vanilla and faded flowers scent. Full-bodied, soft, tannic, of a fine quality with a pleasant bitter aftertaste.

Montepulciano Casale Vecchio 2009, Farnese P 1160.-
Ruby red with garnet reflections, intense, persistent and fruity fragrance, faded flowers, liquorice and spices scent. Good body.

FROM ITALY...

VENETO

Bardolino Classico 2009, Villa Girardi P 1050.-

Characteristic of remarkable refinement, wilted violets on the nose. On the palate, it is sincere and very harmonious with hints of dry roasted nuts, oak and tobacco.

Valpolicella Classico 2009, Villa Girardi P 1130.-

Made from a blend of the indigenous varieties of Corvina, Rondinella & Molinara, the wine has aromas of cherries with hints of mature hay. On the palate it is dry, harmonious with fruitiness.

Valpolicella Superiore Bure Alto 2008, Villa Girardi P 1640.-

The aroma is with hints of mature hay. On the palate, it is rich, warm and vigorous. Of superb balance and elegant complexity.

SICILIA

Cerasuolo di Vittoria 2008, Planeta (Nero d'Avola & Frappato) P 1460.-

Intense ruby-red with black cherry hues. Fruity, reminiscent of red berries, strawberries, cherries, prickly pears and fruit drops on the nose. Juicy, displaying a fresh texture and pleasing contact on the palate.

Santa Cecilia 2006 (Nero d'Avola di Sicilia) P 1950.-

Purple red with violet hues. The aromatic profile relies entirely on where Nero d'Avola originates. Powerful indications of red fruit, carob and liquorices eventually give way to suggestions of mineral and graphite. On the palate, it has vigorous structure, dense and compact tannins and robust body. Acidity is raised and promises a long maturation.

SWEET WINES

PIEMONTE

Moncucco Moscato d'Asti 2007, Fontanafredda P 1430.-

Intense nose of musk, locust and orange flowers, sage and honey and the lingering of its carefree flavour brings the brightest of the spirits. This clear, straw-yellow wine has a pleasant medium sweetness that is very well-balanced and features honey and just picked grapes. A very appealing drink on its own.

FROM THE REST OF THE WORLD...

CHAMPAGNE AND SPARKLING WINES

- Premium Brut, Tyrrell's (Australia)** P 900.-
Premium Brut is an early drinking style, showing full, rich flavours of fruit and with very elegant & refreshing effervescence. Being a non-vintage ensures that the wine is consistent in quality from year to year.
- Chardonnay Brut, Charles de Fere (France)** P 1060.-
Extraordinary pale gold in colour with delicate bubbles. The distinctive Chardonnay aromas of toasted bread-crusts are very pleasant. Elegant and crispy on the palate, yet well-rounded. Velvety with a touch of flintstone. Lasting flavour and a smooth finish.
- Taittinger Brut Reserve, Champagne Taittinger (France)** P 3290.-
The colour is brilliant, golden straw yellow. The bubbles are fine and persistent. The nose exudes aromas of peach, white flowers (may blossom, acacia) and vanilla pod. This is a delicate wine with flavours of fresh fruit and honey. It is aged for three to four years in the cellars where it achieves perfect maturity.

WHITE WINES

AUSTRALIA

- Old Winery Semillon Sauvignon Blanc 2010, Tyrrell's (West. Australia)** P 1020.-
A lively, fresh wine characterized by the grassy aromas of the Sauvignon Blanc grape with clean lemon citrus Semillon flavours on the palate.
- Chardonnay 2009, Leconfield** P 1460.-
Aroma of fresh cut peaches. Fine stone fruit flavours with a long and persistent palate that finishes cleanly with a tight but soft acidity.

CHILE

- Chardonnay 2009, Viña Ventisquero** P 840.-
A yellow-coloured wine with green tones, intense aromas of pineapple, bananas and citrus fruits. On the palate, it is smooth and balanced in acidity.
- Sauvignon Blanc Reserva 2010, Viña Ventisquero** P 845.- *bottle*
P 175.- *glass*
This wine is characterized by its brilliant green colour with yellow tones and intense aromas of tropical and citrus fruit. The style is of ripe fruit, has good structure and balanced acidity.
- Sauvignon Blanc 2010, Peñalolen** P 840.-
With this wine, Penalolen demonstrates how impressive Sauvignon Blanc can be. The use of pure, ripe fruit gives this wine a powerfully rich and complex flavor free from oak or residual sugar. It has aromas of mandarin orange and fresh cut flowers, combined with good acidity.

FROM THE REST OF THE WORLD...

SOUTH AFRICA

Chardonnay Colombard 2010, Douglas Green P 650.-

An attractive composition of Chardonnay and Colombard bringing together tropical fruit flavours, subtle floral and creamy vanilla undertones. Dry and medium-bodied.

Sauvignon Blanc 2009, Bellingham P 920.-

A fantastically fresh and fascinating wine with discreet minerality and appealing floral, green fig and pear drop fragrances and flavours.

NEW ZEALAND

Infamous Goose Sauvignon Blanc 2010, Wild Rock P 1030.-

Named after the grower nicknamed "Goose" and due to the distinctive flavour of gooseberries in Sauvignon Blanc. Fresh and zesty citrus is paired with crisp herbal notes and gooseberries. Marlborough produces a beautifully balanced and fresh Sauvignon Blanc.

ROSÉ WINES

FRANCE

Cote de Provence 2009, Mas de Cadenet P 1220.-

Crisp and delicate, with strawberry and grassy notes. Well-balanced, elegant and showing ample acidity.

FROM THE REST OF THE WORLD...

RED WINES

FRANCE

Chateau Saint-Jacques de Siran 2008 P 1200.-
Fairly light colour, with a pleasantly fruity nose. Some vanilla evident, good autumnal fruits on the palate, with a well defined structure.

SPAIN

Arbucala Esencia Roble Oak-Aged 2007 P 1050.-
This wine is made of 100% tempranillo and has completed six months in american oak barrels. Ruby colour. Persistent and fine aroma, highlighting mint, liquorice and toasted coffee. On the palate is a perfectly balanced wine. The ageing in barrels gives a touch of ripeness and complexity, allowing the wine to express its full personality.

Pesquera Tinto Reserva 2007 (Ribera del Duero) P 2335.-
There are whiffs of well-seasoned fruit, rich hints of cocoa and vanilla, and reminiscences of minerals. Dark forest aromas can be detected in the background. Its strength, lushness and the maturity of its tannins can be appreciated in the mouth. The wood flavors are generously wrapped around the fruit but do not stand out. As a result, it is tasty and balanced wine.

Conrad Soléon 2006 (Andalucia) P 2040.-
A blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc & Merlot and aged in French oak barrels for 18 months; this wine has an expressive nose of red fruits, wood notes and herbaceous aromas. An excellent full-bodied wine and perfect to enjoy now.

AUSTRALIA

Moore's Creek Shiraz 2009, Tyrrell's (South Eastern Australia) P 840.- *bottle*
A rich Shiraz which combines elegant spicy characters and ripe plum fruit with medium body and tannin. P 200.- *glass*

Cabernet Sauvignon 2008, Leconfield (Coonawarra) P 1700.-
Deep dense red with intense ripe cassis fruit nose with a hint of mint balanced aromatic oak with spicy cinnamon/vanilla. Rich fruit with fine long tannins. Excellent richness with the elegance expected of a Leconfield Coonawarra Cabernet Sauvignon. Finishes with clean acidity.

Lucindale Cabernet Sauvignon 2005, DiGiorgio (Coonawarra) P 1580.-
Red brick hues of spicy tobacco nose with some nice cedar oak notes. The palate is perfumed with soft, youthful fruity flavours and fine tannins. Excellent length and finishes dry.

Rufus Stone McLaren Vale Shiraz 2008, Tyrrell's (Victoria) P 1630.-
Fresh aromas of ripe black berries, spicy black pepper and a subtle sweet lift of vanillin oak. The palate is full bodied with a long finish that is reminiscent of pure cocoa chocolate with a savoury edge.

ARGENTINA

Misterio Cabernet Sauvignon 2010, Finca Flichman P 700.- *bottle*
Scented nose, cassis and black pepper, medium-bodied and with great balance. P 150.- *glass*

FROM THE REST OF THE WORLD...

CHILE

- Carmenere Reserva 2009, Viña Ventisquero** P 840.-
An excellent carmenere of intense bluish black colour and aromas of vanilla mixed in black pepper and bitter chocolate. It has velvety tannins behind its great structure.
- Cabernet Sauvignon Gran Reserva 2008, Viña Ventisquero** P 1060.-
A full-flavored wine with hints of ripe plums and black cherries. A very balanced wine of great structure and rich flavor. Superb quality and the best among the range.
- Cabernet Sauvignon 2007, Peñalolen** P 1065.-
Candied blackcurrants, raspberries, plums and blackberries promote a deep nose of sweet chocolate, mocha and coffee. In the mouth are velvety tannins, voluptuous texture offering a bright finish where the fruit pairs with spicy chocolate and tobacco.
- Alba de Domus 2006, Viña Quebrada de Macul** P 1760.-
This complex wine offers blackcurrant, liquor of cherry, orange zest and chocolate with fleshy texture and balance underlining the ripe fruit.

SOUTH AFRICA

- Cabernet Merlot 2009, Bellingham** P 770.-
An intriguing fusion of intense black berry, crushed mulberry and tobacco spice from the Cabernet Sauvignon with juicy ripe plum, lush black cherry and liquorice appeal of the Merlot. A perfect blend.
- Pinotage 2008, Bellingham** P 910.-
Pinotage is an exciting rendition of South Africa's unique variety (the cross between Pinot Noir & Cinsaut); enticing with liberal lashings of ripe mulberry juicy raspberry, roast coffee beans, clove spice and vanilla oak. Light to medium body.

NEW ZEALAND

- Gravel Pit Merlot Malbec 2009, Wild Rock** P 1050.-
Dark with ripe black berry fruit and plummy varietal characters with aromas of chocolate. Gripping tannins and a lively persistent finish make for a sublime relaxing wine.
- Cupid's Arrow Pinot Noir 2008, Wild Rock** P 1230.-
Dense ruby red in colour this Pinot Noir has red berry and black cherry fruits mixed with the wild herb and floral characters. A soft textured palate with fine grainy tannins and a spicy, dried fruit character on the finish.
